In total 12 awards were handed out for greenfield European transactions and 4 refinancings. A total of 4 deals – all of them greenfield – were awarded across Sub Saharan Africa.

On the companies front, 13 organisations – all of them chosen by the independent panel of judges – were recognised for their achievements at the awards night.

An innovation for this year saw the judging panel challenged with identifying their choice of winner. This involved debate over which organisations have been most influential across the region... and resulted in them choosing a government body that is not even in the region!
